



# REOPENING YOUR SHOWROOM BEST PRACTICES

## AVOID AT ALL COSTS



Offering communal snacks & utilizing shared resources.



Crowding areas of the showroom.



Allowing sick employees to work on-site. A temperature of 100.4° is considered dangerous.



### BE CAUTIOUS OF

- Serving communal coffee
- Allowing children in the showroom
- Allowing more than 2 customers per employee
- Handling your customers personal items (outerwear, books or binder)



### SAFE TO DO

- Offer customers face masks
- Provide hand washing stations
- Sanitize all items touched by customers
- Take employee temperatures
- Accept touchless payment

## TIPS TO AVOID GETTING SICK



Always wear a face covering.



Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.



When present, stand on floor markings until those in front of you move forward.



Ensure you have ample cleaning products and hand sanitizer available.



Keep at least 6 feet between one another at all times.



Avoid contact with people who are sick.

**Social Distancing:** the act of keeping a 6-foot distance from others and avoiding close contact.
